

Year 7 to Year 11: Key content and skills - ART

Y11

Students will further develop their use of media, technique and initiative with a more independent way of learning facilitated by the classroom teacher. They will work towards finishing two projects from different starting points and work on their final exam piece released in January. Students are assessed on their ability to meet 4 assessment objectives. set by AQA.

Y10

Students will engage in workshop-based learning becoming more proficient in skills such as: mono-printing, lino cutting, etching, observational drawing, painting, photography, clay reliefs and researching artists they have found, of interest. Students will be given the starting point of 2 projects for which they must create, and complete portfolios inspired by artists they have found. Students are assessed on their ability to meet 4 assessment objectives set by AQA.

Y9

Students will further enhance their skills in analysing artwork in more challenging Art movements such as Op Art and Street Art in order to enhance their critical analysis offering opinions at a much greater depth. Students will be given the chance to have a brief in order to create their own artwork using a more GCSE focused way of producing art.

Y8

Students will use their previous skill set in their work focusing on creating artwork with a focus on Art movements to influence their art such as Pop Art, Surrealism and Abstract art. Student will learn the basics of sculptural art through the use of clay and will enhance their skills in being able to analyse artists' work within an Art Movement and being able to form an opinion on the artists' work.
