

Year 7 to Year 11: Key content and skills - **DRAMA**

Y11

BTEC Tech Award Performing Arts Year Two. Students will devise their own scripts, organise their own performance festival from scratch and interpret published play texts independently choosing their own Theatre Practitioner style and skills set in rehearsal. They will also complete their skills audit.

Y10

BTEC Tech Award Performing Arts Year One. Throughout the course, students undertake a skills audit. Students will develop an understanding of the skills required in the theatre industry; they will reflect, devise and script performances. They will show their individual contribution to the rehearsal process and how the work of others influences individual's development of skills and techniques.

Y9

Subtext, The Identification, Blood Brothers, The Shadow of a Gunman and Teechers. Students will be introduced to the work and taught skills of famous Drama practitioners; exploring Frantic Assembly, Stanislavski and Brecht through workshops. They will utilise their bespoke skills in performance and evaluating their success.

Y8

Students will develop their devising and script-work skills, bringing alive performances from the page to the stage. A greater emphasis will be on developing their skills in the technical elements of theatre (lighting, sound, costume, props and set design), as well as further embedding their performance skills.
