PE KIT

I would just like to take this opportunity to remind you all of the PE kit requirements.

School PE kit is as follows:

Outdoor kit

- Blue reversible shirt (with school logo)
- Navy shorts [skort is an option for girls], (with school logo)
- Blue and white socks - long
- Boots and shin pads
- Gum shield


Indoor kit

- Blue polo shirt (with school logo)
- Blue shorts [skort an option for girls], (with school logo)
- White gym/tennis socks – long blue/gold socks (as above)

We appreciate that during some periods of this year you may not have always been able to purchase the correct PE kit, but this should no longer be a problem. Therefore, in order to maintain the high standards that are expected, from the **17th May**, students who fail to bring or do not have the correct kit will be required to borrow school kit. A risk assessment has been completed to ensure this process is safe, with all kit being washed after each use. Also, unless there is a severe medical reason which means students cannot change, students are still expected to bring and change into PE kit. They will still be involved in lesson and take up leadership and officiating roles.
