RETURN TO SCHOOL GRANTS

Are now available from Racing Welfare to families in the horseracing and breeding industries with dependent, school age children (4-18 years).

GRANTS ARE TO:

- Assist with return to school expenses such as uniform and educational equipment.
- To prevent financial difficulties for families working in the Thoroughbred horseracing and breeding industries.

YOU MUST BE:

- Either currently employed or self-employed in the Thoroughbred horseracing and breeding industries within the last year.
- And/or lost your job or work or be on furlough.
- Living on or below the Minimum Income Standard, to check this go to: www.minimumincome.org.uk
- In receipt of Child Benefit for all applicable children.

FURTHER INFO:

- Grants are for £100 per child up to a maximum of 4 children per family.
- The fund will close on **30th September 2020** or before if all available funds are used first.
