

Parent/Guardian rings in to:

A) alert us to suspected Covid case and awaiting testing

OR

B) alert us to student self-isolating for 14 days

JOG Office make initial phone call home to students who are awaiting tests or self-isolating, to ascertain if they can work.

If able to work, 48 hour emergency work pack will be sent home by Progress Leader OR can be accessed on the website – Covid tab

Student to submit work to class teachers via TEAMS

Progress Leader will do a follow up phone call to support student/parent

If absence is for longer than 3 days, work aligned to the Curriculum being taught in school will be sent home via Classcharts and TEAMS by Class Teachers

What we are doing to support individual students who are awaiting testing or self-isolating

How parents can support:

Please help us by:

- Ensuring your child accesses work set and submits work, if they are not ill.
- Helping your child to access work on Classcharts and TEAMS and let us know if they can't.
- Supporting your child to keep in regular contact with teachers and their Form Tutor.
- Visiting the website COVID tab for support when students are remote learning, or contact the JOG office who will field queries.
- Maintaining good communication with your child's Form Tutor and /or Progress Leader

Accessing work

All work will be flagged up on ClassCharts but often teachers will redirect students to work within TEAMS. Assignments may also be set in TEAMS. There are support videos on how to log in to the various platforms on the COVID tab.

If accessing the internet is difficult, we can send paper copies of work.

Did you know?

If a test has NOT been secured by the 5th day of absence, students will have to automatically self-isolate for 14 days according to Government guidance. Please contact the school if you are struggling to obtain a test. If we can avoid time off, we must.
