

Year 7 to Year 11: Key content and skills - **FRENCH**

Y11

In year 11 topics include social issues and the world of work. They can express and justify both their own and others' points of view and translate a paragraph from English into French. They are also introduced to extracts of French Literature.

Y10

In year 10 pupils begin the GCSE course. They learn to discuss more complex issues such as future relationships, new technology and environmental and social issues. They study more complex grammar, allowing them to communicate in a more sophisticated way.

Y9

In year 9, pupils are able to understand longer extracts, interpret attitudes and understand three time frames. They continue to improve their fluency and pronunciation.

Y8

Pupils build upon previous knowledge, learning to understand longer more complex extracts, to express opinions and refer to more than one time frame.
